RWBAHC has no Emergency Department

Dial 911 for Emergencies



Canyon Vista Regional Health Center is located at 5700 East Highway 90. Emergency treatment is available at their emergency room 24 hours a day. TRICARE billing of acute or urgent conditions is based on whether a prudent person would go to an emergency room for treatment, or wait and see their PCM. Be advised to use the "Prudent Law" when the emergency room is utilized. That is, immediate medical attention is needed with a threat to life, limb, or sight; when a person has severe, painful symptoms requiring immediate attention to relieve suffering; or when a person is at immediate risk to self or others.

CAUTION: TRICARE Prime enrollees may incur out-of-pocket costs for inappropriate Emergency Room/Urgent Care use.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH).** RWBAHC and MEDCOM subscribe to the PCMH model of primary care that is patient-centered, comprehensive, team-based, coordinated, accessible, and focused on quality and safety. Your PCMH is a place where patients are treated with respect, dignity, and compassion, and enables strong and trusting relationships with your PCM and support staff. With PCMH you, the patient, are the center of all we do. RWBAHC also provides preventive medicine consultation and Physical Therapy services for Active Duty personnel Monday thru Friday. Optometry services are open for all Active Duty, Dependents, and Retirees. Access to medical care at RWBAHC is by appointment unless otherwise stated.
- 2. Weekend/Health Access Clinic (WHAC):** Urgent and acute minor illness medical care is provided for Active Duty personnel and TRICARE Prime beneficiaries enrolled to RWBAHC. Please call (520) 533-9165 during this clinic's hours (0730-1600) to schedule an appointment. The clinic is located in the main Health Center, Bldg. 45001 and the main front entrance will be open from 0700-1600 every weekend and on Training Holidays (RWBAHC is now closed for all Federal Holidays).
- 3. Nurse Advice Line/After Hours Care.** The TRICARE Nurse Advice Line is available to RWBAHC beneficiaries who have medical questions. Please call the TRICARE Nurse Advice Line at 1-800-874-2273. Services include home healthcare advice, answers to a multitude of medical questions, and authorizations to seek after-hours care at the Urgent Care Clinic if deemed necessary. Please note the Nurse Advice Line is not for medication renewals, test results, or other communication with your PCM team. These requests can be made through Relay Health Secure Messaging Service, which provides secure communication between the patient and their PCM or PCM Team. PLEASE NOTE: A referral is not necessary for going to an Emergency Room.

APPOINTMENTS

To access medical appointments, please call (520) 533-9200 or toll free 1-877-856-2821 from 0600-1500, Monday to Friday. All beneficiaries may also utilize the TRICARE Online appointment system 24 hours/7 days a week for their primary care needs. Multiple services are available once registered with TRICARE Online at <http://www.tricareonline.com/> (i.e. schedule, cancel appointments, prescription refills, personal health data and email/text message reminders). Medical care can also be accessed via **Relay Health (a.k.a. Secure Messaging)** at <https://app.mil.relayhealth.com/>. Secure Messaging is an online portal enabling the patient to have open communication lines directly with their PCM/PCM Team through secured e-mail messages.

ACTIVE DUTY PATIENTS – Soldier Centered Clinic

- a. Active Duty permanent party, permanent party flight personnel, Officer Basic and Advance Course** students receive medical care at the **Soldier Centered Clinic, Bldg 51101, Monday to Friday, 0700-1500, by appointment only.** Patients (except flight personnel) must call or go online to schedule an appointment. Flight personnel can book appointments by calling 538-1546. For clinic information or assistance, please call 533-2627.
- b. AIT students, NCO Academy students, AIT flight students, and re-class students** receive their medical care at the **MI Student Clinic, Bldg 84551.** Hours of operation are Monday to Friday from 0445-1400. **Student sick call is held at this clinic and check-in is from 0445-0500.** Students should check with their Cadre for a sick call slip. Please call 533-6709 for clinic information or assistance.
- c. Soldier Readiness Activities** which include all Active Duty installation medical in/out-processing, individual medical readiness, MEDPROS updates, deployment SRP medical activities and post deployment health reassessment evaluations are provided at Soldier Centered Clinic. Please call 533-2627 for information or assistance. Soldiers are seen by appointment only. All part 1 Active Duty separation physicals to include retirement, ETS, chapters, and airborne physicals are walk-in from 0715-1200, Monday to Wednesday and Friday (closed on Thursday). Part 2 physicals are by appointment only.

FAMILY MEMBERS AND RETIREES – Family Care Clinics A and B

All non-Active Duty beneficiaries enrolled to a RWBAHC PCM receive primary medical care by appointment at R.W. Bliss Army Health Center Family Care Clinics (A and B), Bldg 45001. To access RWBAHC clinics or services, call 533-9200 from 0600-1500.

RWBAHC beneficiaries needing guidance with appointments, medical care, medication renewals, LAB/RAD results and referrals during the duty day, should call (520) 533-9200 ext. 1 and request a **nurse telephone consult**. Your information will be taken and sent to the nurse assigned to your PCM. Expected timeframe for staff-to-patient response or prescription renewal is within 72 hours.

Family member immunizations: We do not have a specified immunization clinic. Immunizations are conducted with your Primary Care Team on a walk-in basis between the hours of 0730–1500, with lunch at 1130-1300. Please remember we have Training Day on Thursdays, so immunizations are not available until 0900. Patients 0 to 6 years of age will receive their immunization at their well baby/child visit. Patients older than 6 years of age can get immunizations without seeing a provider. Call your Primary Care Clinic at either 533-9165 (FCC-A) or 533-9034 (FCC-B) for information. Please ensure you bring all your hard copy immunization records.
